

## Overview of Year 11 History Curriculum

Pupils will complete the AQA Specification B Modern World History GCSE Course begun in Year 10. Pupils will study the content and skills required for Paper 2, which will be sat at the end of the year.

**Paper 2:** Governments in Action in the First Half of the Twentieth Century.

- a) Germany, 1918 - 1939. This includes the study of the Weimar Republic; Hitler and the growth of the Nazi Party; the establishment of a Nazi Dictatorship; and Nazi Rule in the 1930s.
- b) The USA, 1919 - 1941. This includes the study of the growth of isolation after the First World War; features of 1920s society; the causes and effects of the depression; and Roosevelt and the New Deal.

## Homework

Pupils will have homework set weekly, which will consist of written work, including source questions, improving the quality of coursework, and revision for the final examinations.

## Assessment (External)

**Coursework:** Pupils coursework (completed largely in Year 10) will comprise 25% of their final GCSE mark.

**Examinations:** Pupils will sit two papers at the end of the year which in total comprises 75% of the final mark (each paper is worth 37.5%).

- Ensure that all coursework is completed to a high standard.
- Encourage your son to attend additional coursework and revision sessions.
