

## MFL - Listening

- Level 1 I can understand the odd sentence, especially if my teacher mimes, repeats or if there is a picture.
- Level 2 I can understand short sentences if we have done the words before. I don't need my teacher to mime or a picture, but I may need them to repeat.
- Level 3 I can understand 3-4 sentences about a topic we have done. I can write down the important bits. I only need a couple of things repeated.
- Level 4 I can understand more than 4 sentences about a topic we have done said quickly. I can pick out the important bits and write them down, but I may need to have a couple of things repeated.
- Level 5 I can understand more than 4 sentences said quickly about different topics we have done in the present and past **or** future. I can pick out the important bits and write them down, but I need to have a couple of thing repeated.
- Level 6 I can understand short extracts said quickly about different topics we have done in the present, past **and** future. I can pick out the important bits and write them down. I understand when they happened (present, past or future) and I hardly need anything to be repeated.
- Level 7 I can understand long passages of French or Spanish as it would be spoken by adults about a number of familiar and unfamiliar topics. I hardly ever need to have anything repeated.
- Level 8 I can understand long passages of French or Spanish as it would be spoken by adults about a number of topics many of them unfamiliar. I recognise from the words used how people feel about a topic. I hardly ever need to have anything repeated.

## MFL - Speaking

- Level 1 I can say a few words or a phrase in French/Spanish.
- Level 2 I can answer simple questions, and use set phrases. I can ask my teacher for help in French/Spanish.
- Level 3 I can have a short conversation in French/Spanish and I can talk about the things I like and don't like.
- Level 4 I can make up a longer conversation in French/Spanish. I sound a lot more French/Spanish now.
- Level 5 I can ask and answer questions and can take part in longer conversations. I can refer to past or future plans as well as everyday activities. I can make myself understood with little difficulty.
- Level 6 I can have a conversation about things that I do, have done and am going to do. I can give and ask for information about routine things. I make myself understood with no difficulty.
- Level 7 I can give views about myself and current affairs. I can cope with unexpected questions. My pronunciation is good.
- Level 8 I can speak confidently about a number of topics like an adult. My pronunciation is really good.

## MFL - Reading

- Level 1 I can read a short list of words.
- Level 2 I can read short sentences.
- Level 3 I can read short conversations and passages.
- Level 4 I can read a short text or story.
- Level 5 I can read about the present and past or future in texts from a magazine, short book or brochure.
- Level 6 I can read a magazine or a short book. I can understand about whether things in the past, present and future. I can guess the meaning of new words and I choose extra reading material for myself.
- Level 7 I can read difficult texts about a number of topics containing new vocabulary.
- Level 8 I can read lots of different difficult texts for interest and for information. I can understand unfamiliar topics involving complicated language.

## MFL - Writing

- Level 1 I can copy single words correctly.
- Level 2 I can copy short phrases and sentences.
- Level 3 I can write short sentences from memory or make it up using wall displays or textbooks.
- Level 4 I can write short paragraphs of 3 or 4 sentences from memory. I know how to use a dictionary to find new words.
- Level 5 I can write in paragraphs using simple sentences about what I do and have done recently or will do soon. My French/Spanish will be mostly correct.
- Level 6 I can write using paragraphs about what I do, have done recently and will do soon. I can change lots of the words in a sentence I have seen in books to fit me. My writing is accurate.
- Level 7 I can write quite long pieces about imaginary events and will do my work several times until I get it just right.
- Level 8 I can write very difficult pieces about adult topics stating my own and other people's points of view. I use dictionaries, books and reference materials to improve my work which is very accurate.
