

Overview of Year 11 Drama GCSE Edexcel

Pupils in Year 10 have three lessons a week if they choose it as one of their option subjects.

Term 1 - Pupils are taught:-

- How to devise a piece of drama
- How to adopt a playtext
- Coursework catch up and improvement

Term 2 - Pupils are taught:-

- Practicals for paper 2

Term 3 - Pupils are taught:-

- Practicals for paper 2
- External examiner performance
- Portfolio coursework completed

Assessment

Pupils are assessed continuously in their drama by the class teacher, other pupils and themselves as they evaluate their performances every lesson. Their formal assessment is both practical and written and assessed every half term.
