Assessment

Each unit of work is marked separately, and recorded in school. The creation of these then portfolios are internally marked and then standardised, these are then verified by an external moderator and credits allocated to the pupil. At the end of the course all the completed units are collated and the correct certification awarded.

Guidance will be given to all the boys as to which units would be most appropriate for them in terms of what they have to complete to gain the highest award in relation to their ability and time commitments.
