

## **Overview of Year 11 Maths Curriculum**

In Year 11, pupils continue with the GCSE Edexcel Mathematics course at either Foundation or Higher level.

The course consists of the same areas of study as Year 10.

Pupils are encouraged and required to build on their knowledge from KS3 and Year 10, developing their mathematical thinking skills.

## **Homework**

This is set once a week in line with the whole school homework policy. All homework at KS4 is set online using MyMaths.co.uk. A detention will be issued if homework is not regularly completed.

## **Examinations/Key assessments**

### **Edexcel GCSE Maths**

Assessment takes place in June in the form of an examination.

### **Edexcel GCSE Statistics**

Assessment takes place in June in the form of an examination. In addition a piece of coursework is required by April.

## **How Parents can Help**

- Check that homework is recorded in planners and that any work is completed to a good standard.
- Ensure that basic equipment is brought to each lesson. A pencil and ruler are the minimum requirements.
- Encourage the use of the Internet for homework completion and revision.
- Ensure pupils revise for exams.
