

## Overview of Year 7 RE Curriculum

In year 7 pupils follow three modules of work, one for each term. This is in line with the Liverpool's Revised Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education.

In term one pupils study the theme of **Visions of life/ Inspirational Figures**.

This topic covers aspects of Christianity, Buddhism and Islam. (Focusing on key figures from the latter two).

In term two pupils will study **Jesus' vision**.

This topic continues from the last, but is a more concentrated study on the central figure of Christianity.

In term three pupils will study **Islam**.

This topic offers an opportunity to make a focussed study of Islam as a major world faith.

## Homework

Homework supports the work undertaken in the classroom and so it is important that it is finished to a satisfactory standard. Pupils will be encouraged to develop their research skills and use of I.C.T.

## Examinations/Key assessments

In year 7 and 8 pupils will complete three "Assessment for Learning" tasks, one for each term. They will be given specific advice and examples of what they will need to do in order to achieve a particular level.

Please take an active interest in the themes being studied in Religious Education. If possible take time to discuss any homework that has been set and help if necessary. Pupils should be encouraged to use the internet to investigate topics, however they should understand that work that has simply been downloaded will not be acceptable.
